

COVID-19: ongoing measures

16 March 2020

In the context of the state of emergency declared by the Spanish and Portuguese health authorities to limit the spread of COVID-19, we have taken extraordinary measures at Uría Menéndez to protect the health and safety of our staff, clients and other professionals, while we continue to provide our legal services. The measures are summarised below.

- Madrid, Barcelona, Valencia, Bilbao and Lisbon offices

The vast majority of our staff and all our lawyers are teleworking. However, all these offices remain open and our basic services continue to be fully operational.

- Events

All events due to take place in our offices in the next few weeks have been cancelled, except for those that can be organised under the current regulations.

- Meetings

At Uría Menéndez, we are deploying all the means and resources at our disposal to guarantee the safety of all our members and minimise the risks and uncertainty created by the current situation. The above measures are provisional and will be reviewed as the circumstances require.
